CTA SETTLEMENT AGREEMENTS - AT A GLANCE

The following information is your guide to the most recent settlements. This information may be used to help you advocate for CTA members who may need support in the following areas.

MULTIPLE POSITION PREP TIME

Is there a member with multiple contracts equalling 0.4 or more?

-A teacher who has assignments at more than one school totalling 0.4 or more, prep time should be scheduled accordingly.

Continuing Part Time Teachers Working 100%

Is there a member who has been in a continuing part time position in a school being supplemented in a similar program area totalling to a 1.0 position?

After 2 consecutive years, this member's position should be converted into a 1.0 Continuing Full Time Contact

TEACHER-LIBRARIAN PREP TIME

Does the Teacher-Librarian at your school have concerns about their preparation time?

Teacher Librarian FTE for non-enrolling ratios will include only work that is reasonably part of the TL's responsibilities. Coverage provided by TLs for classroom teachers cannot be counted unless it is within the scope of the TL's role.
