## Pregnancy/Parental leave for Temporary Contract Teachers

If you are in a temporary contract you are eligible for supplemental employment benefits (known as 'top up'). However, you are only eligible to collect 'top up' for the duration of your contract or until June 30. If you obtain a contract in September, you are able to receive the remaining weeks of your 'top up'. You are required to apply for EI maternity Benefits in the second week of your pregnancy leave. Failure to do so may result in over payment of EI benefits.
